PID 6 GUIDELINES FOR STANDING COMMITTEES

1. Complete application form and send to PID 6 manager via fax, e-mail or U.S. mail.
2. All applicants must reside on a lot within the boundaries of PID 6 and the owner of the lot must be current on their PID 6 Assessment.
3. There may be only one vote per lot on a committee.
4. Members will be appointed by the PID 6 Advisory Board; all candidates will be informed within ten (10) days of the first PID 6 Advisory Board meeting held after completed application form is received.
5. New members must attend three (3) meetings prior to holding a voting position on a committee.
6. Any member who does not attend three (3) consecutive meetings may be removed from the committee and if approved will have to re-apply for re-appointment.
7. One member of the committee shall be a liaison to the PID 6 Advisory Board and shall submit a written report when required. The liaison may address the Advisory Board at the PID 6 Advisory Board meetings.
8. There will be a suggested minimum of three (3) members on a committee.
